CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: We are happy to share the details of the commendable performance of our students of Grade LKG to XII. There is an appealing story of success in co-curricular activities as always, in various school events at District Level, State Level, National Level and International Level. The performance of our students were impressive in interschool and intra school competitions. Quiz Fest conducted by M.C.High School on Bharathiyar’s Anniversary day and in Puranava competition organized by GOD TRUST OF INDIA, our kids grabbed many prizes.
